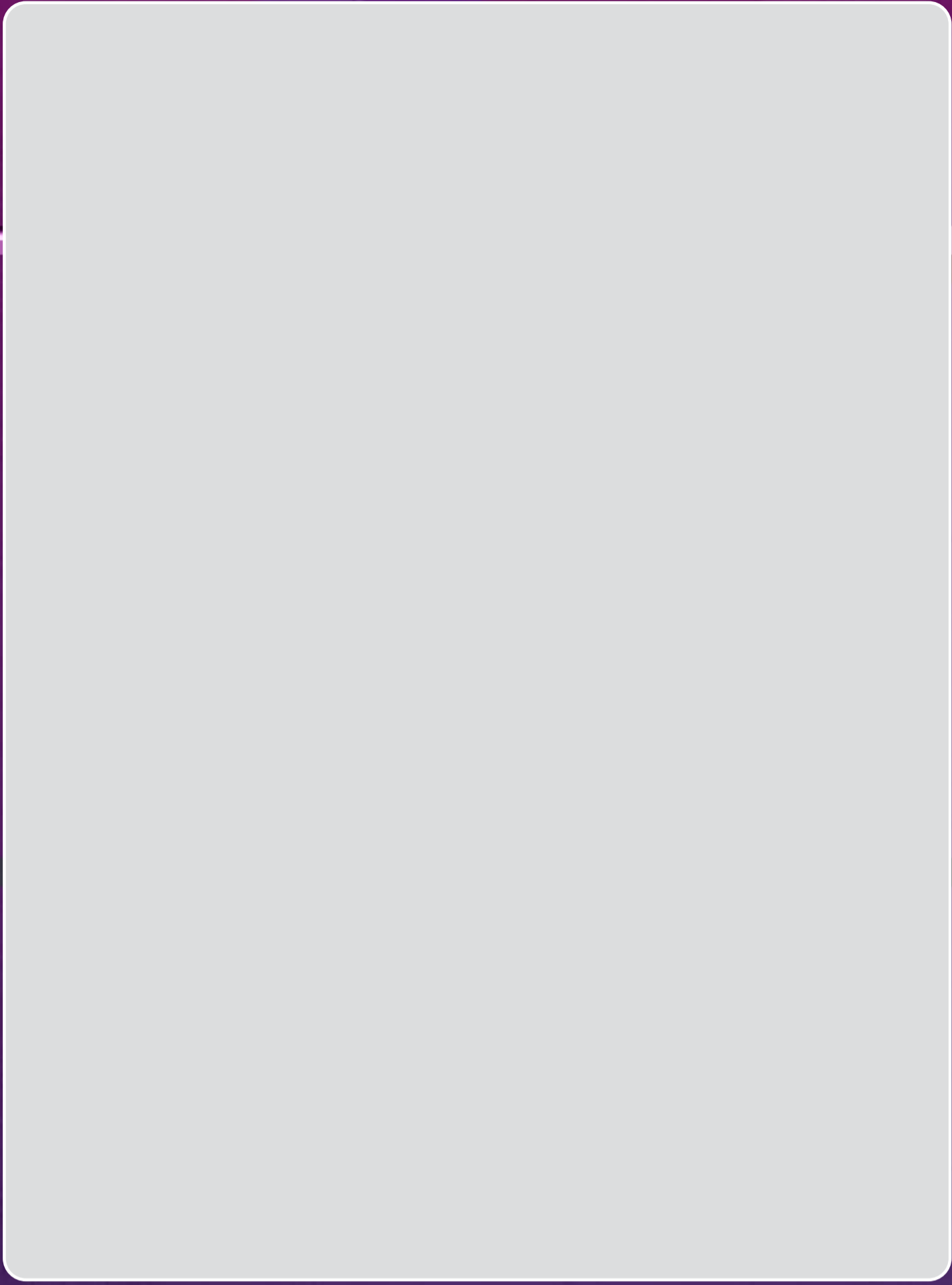
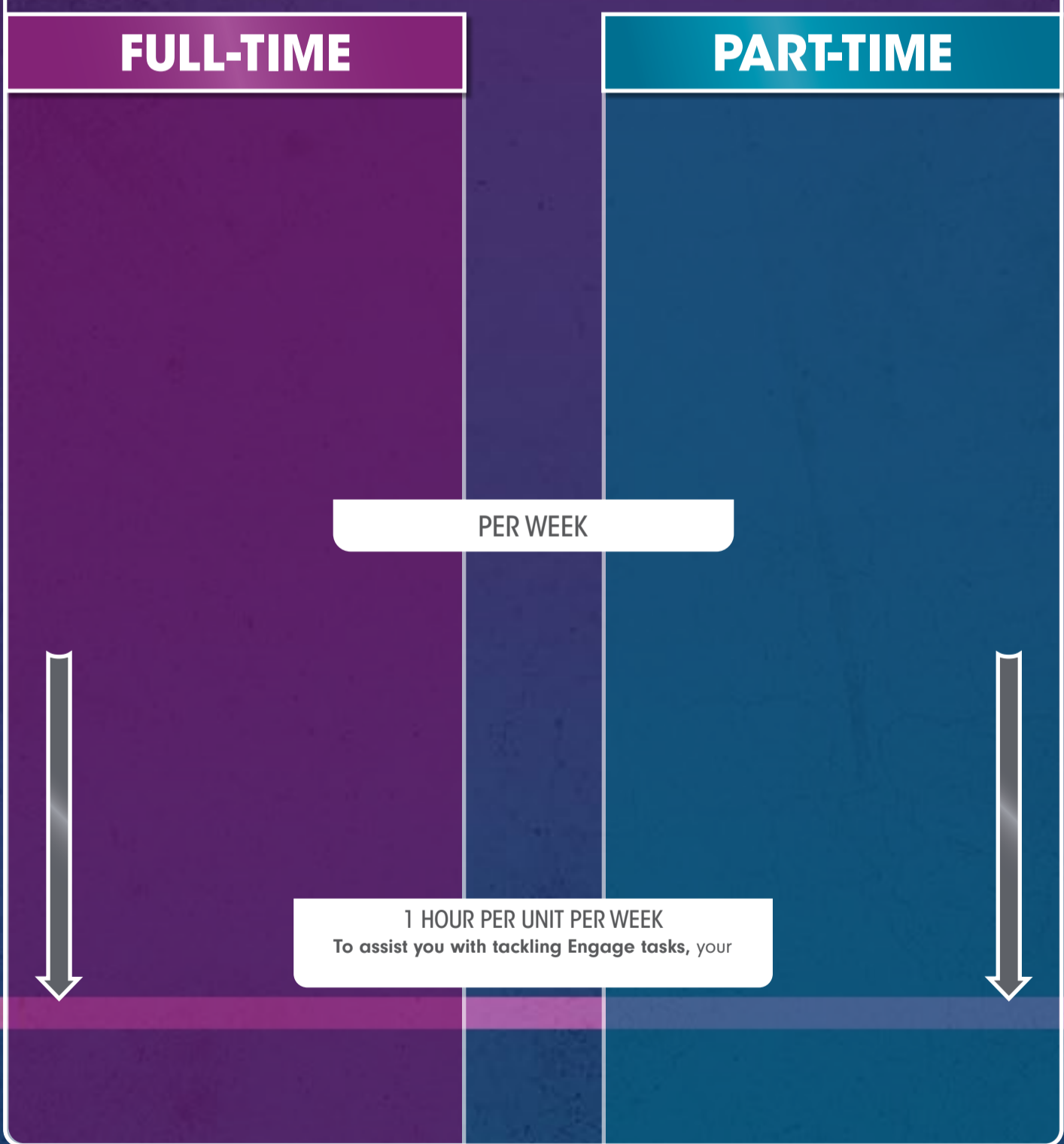


# LPC ONLINE
